Pharmacoepidemiology and Drug Safety is the major journal devoted to the field of Pharmacoepidemiology. It is the official journal of the International Society for Pharmacoepidemiology and has an impact factor of 2.516. Brian L. Strom, MD, MPH serves as Editor-in-Chief. We seek a Regional Editor for the Asia-Pacific Region, the Middle East, and Africa, to serve as a counterpart to the Regional Editor for Europe and the Regional Editor for the Americas.

Duties:

We seek a part-time Regional Editor to manage manuscripts submitted for the Asia-Pacific Region, the Middle East, and Africa. Duties include:

- Read, review, evaluate submitted manuscripts.
- Ensure that manuscripts fit the mission and style of the journal.
- Recruit at least two external peer reviewers for each manuscript.
- Critique the manuscript and, with the advice of the peer reviewers, decide on whether the manuscript should be accepted, and issue decision letters to the authors.
- Attend Editorial Board meetings, held during the annual meeting of the International Society for Pharmacoepidemiology, and be available for conference calls as needed.

Qualifications:

- Prominent scientist and contributor to the field of Pharmacoepidemiology.
- Record of publications and peer reviewing, preferably including in and for *Pharmacoepidemiology and Drug Safety*.
- Excellent command of English as a written and spoken language.
- History of involvement with the International Society for Pharmacoepidemiology and/or other pharmacoepidemiology or pharmacovigilance societies; knowledgeable of regional pharmacoepidemiologic activities.
- Record of academic achievement.
- Residence in the Asia-Pacific Region, Middle East, or Africa.
